

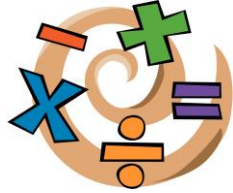
# 3B Weekly News

Greetings to all 3B families!

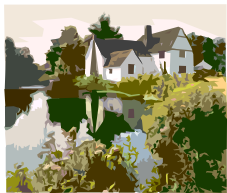
